



# contributions to the history of concepts

The former Newsletter of the History of Political and Social Concepts Group (HPSCG) is being replaced by a publication entitled Contributions to the History of Concepts.

Continuing with the tradition established by the Newsletter, CONTRIBUTIONS will publish articles and book reviews on subjects that are pertinent to conceptual history and neighboring fields of inquiry (history of political and social thought, intellectual history, etc). CONTRIBUTIONS also encourages authors to submit short summations of their recently published books. In addition, CONTRIBUTIONS has sections on news and announcements, annotated bibliographical references and lists, and conference reports.

Articles should have a maximum length of 7,500 words or 50,000 characters including bibliography and notes. Book reviews and author's summaries should have a maximum length of 3,000 words or 20,000 characters including bibliography.

CONTRIBUTIONS only accepts manuscripts in English.

CONTRIBUTIONS will circulate both in printed-paper and in PDF format. This electronic format allows for the issue to be printed on regular computer printers and thus to be easily assembled into a brochure format. Alternatively, the PDF file can also be read on the computer screen. The idea behind this two-fold strategy is to allow for a wider circulation, a necessary measure given the international profile of the publication.

CONTRIBUTIONS will be published biannually, with issues coming out in January and in July.

The newly appointed editors of CONTRIBUTIONS are João Feres Júnior ([jferes@iuperj.br](mailto:jferes@iuperj.br)) and Sandro Chignola ([chisa@sis.it](mailto:chisa@sis.it)), and ITS editorial board is composed of selected members of the HPSCG and other internationally distinguished scholars.
